British Engineering Institutions’ membership Requirements

1. If your degree is not an accredited degree **OR** your degree is from outside the UK, you will be subjected to Academic Assessment by the institution; to ensure that your academic studies are complying with the Engineering Council ECUK standards and that they were adequate to provide you with the engineering basics
2. By completing your degree you should be at least had completed 5 years of engineering courses study **OR** 3 years followed by a master’s degree.
3. You have adequate years of proven professional experience subsequent to your academic degree **OR** a master’s degree (**required ONLY for Chartered Engineer CEng registration**)
4. Submit Proven and documented record of your claimed professional experience; elaborating on ALL your achievements and tasks since your graduation to be evidence on your further learning
5. Undergoing written test or personal interview or BOTH according to the institution’s policy (**required ONLY for Chartered Engineer CEng registration**)

Needed Documentation for Membership**;

1. Application form
2. Transcript/syllabus
3. Qualification certificate
4. Detailed CV
5. Self assessment form (subject to the relevant institution)
6. Final year project summary/Postgraduate thesis summary where applicable
7. Other supporting evidence / Professional record
8. Photocopy of your training certificates
9. Fees

The institution will review all your documentation, academic assessment results and test/interview results then will inform you with the outcome

****ALL documents should be ORIGINAL and in ENGLISH; except what is mentioned otherwise**

If you gained the Chartered Engineer Status;

1. CEng is recognized by the Engineering council **ECUK**
2. You became eligible to apply for the European qualification, **Eur Ing**
3. You are legally entitled to put the letters **CEng** after your name
4. You became **internationally recognized** in more than 100 countries.
